# 7 Business from Correspondence:

- 7.1 Vehicle Inspectors and Vehicle Registrar have arranged to inspect a members multiple car collection, due to the logistics of bringing them all to a General meeting
- 7.2 The go ahead has been given to use a new Bookkeeper to audit the Clubs books for the previous 2 financial years, as well as this financial year

#### 8 New Business

- 8.1 Membership Renewals will be sent out shortly, please keep an eye out. Also remember that if you have a concessional licenced vehicle and payment is not made by the 30<sup>th</sup> June 2019, your vehicle will be deemed unregistered under the code 404 act
- 8.2 Treasurer will be updating the new membership forms so that it mirrors the clubs database for ease of inputting the information
- 8.3 All new members transferring their concessional licenced vehicle onto the club register, needs the HCC to inspect their vehicle before it can be transferred onto our books. They also are required to supply us with a copy of their Registration
- 8.4 Country vehicle inspectors are to be sourced from the CMC, by the members who are unable to bring their car to a club general meeting, for inspection
- 8.5 President is phoning the members with concessional licenced vehicles that have not returned their paperwork

## 9 CMC Report

- 9.1 Peter Taylor and Neville Horner will not be standing for re-election as Treasurer and Secretary, therefore can any clubs help fill these positions?
- 9.2 Patric O'Callaghan is the new manager for the Motor Museum, they are also looking for clubs who want to put in cars for a 2 month display, and are also chasing more volunteers.
- 9.3 Classic Car Show profits down by approx 50% due to higher one off costs and lower attendance. Also one club behaved badly at the show by refusing to use their allocated spot and forced their way through to the lawn area.

- 9.4 At the meeting between the CMC and DoT, DoT produced a number of photos showing heavily modified vehicles on concessional licence. They wanted to know how this could happen, and it was explained that there is no longer an annual inspection. Therefore clubs might not know if the vehicles were modified after licencing. Owners of those vehicles will be receiving a letter advising they have five days to present their cars for inspection and if they fail to comply they will be referred to the police. DoT will also investigate whether the clubs involved are condoning the behavior, which could result in the withdrawal of their concessional approval. As at 12 March 2019 there are 8589 concessionally licenced vehicles owned by 4544 registered owners.
- 9.5 There will be a Special Meeting held on the 17<sup>th</sup> June 2019, with the purpose to accept or reject the CMC new Rules (Constitution). There is no provision for proxy votes, therefore all clubs are encouraged to attend and vote on this matter. The Rules (Constitution) document is being revised and will be issued to all clubs for review prior to the Special Meeting.
- 9.6 CMC general account balance \$24,823, Term Deposit \$41,968 and Classic Car show account \$23,859. CMC would also like suggestions from clubs for the use of the interest earned from the Term Deposit (approx \$1000 per year)
